



Beginning March 12-14, 2007, the National Onsite Wastewater Recycling Association (NOWRA) will host the 1st International Conference addressing *WATER FOR ALL LIFE – A DECENTRALIZED INFRASTRUCTURE FOR A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE* at the Marriott Waterfront Hotel, Baltimore, Maryland.

This International forum brings together for the first time ever in the US, a distinctive group of North American and International experts to share their knowledge, research, expertise, strategies and case studies for achieving sustainability in future water resource use through greater use of decentralized systems.

The NOWRA/EPA Model Code Regulator Education Workshop occurs on Sunday, March 11, and is open to all regulators and policy officials seeking to understand how to change or adapt local and state codes for new technology.
