



Train the Trainer Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems Educational Materials

The purpose of this Train-the-Trainer workshop is to provide professionals who work with communities served by onsite or decentralized wastewater systems with learning materials that can be customized to provide interactive education about Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems. Funds provided by EPA were used to develop the "Onsite Wastewater Treatment System User Guide" & corresponding educational materials.

Concepts covered in this training course include: the importance of wastewater treatment, an overview of treatment in an onsite system, typical onsite system features, final treatment and dispersal, management, maintenance, safety, and system troubleshooting. While the module's target audience is property owners who have an onsite system, the concepts are also applicable to the public, realtors, local health officials, and septic system professionals.
