





Learn about new required standards for septic systems

To improve their performance and to help reduce pollution in our groundwater and Biscayne Bay, The Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources, Division of Environmental Resources Management (RER-DERM), is implementing more ingroups standards for new and replacement onsite sewage treatment and disposal systems (OSTDS), commonly referred to as septic tanks or septic systems. There are currently approximately 110,000 properties in the county with septic systems, and these use sewage treatment technologies dating back to the 1800's. Recent studies show that these systems are a source of pollution for the environment.
