This form is a fill-able template that can be accessed from the OESAC website at www.oesac.com, under the menu heading: "CEU Process." Roster Report Form Instructions are also available at this menu heading. OESAC approves courses for three years from the date of course approval. During this period no re-evaluation is needed for repeat offerings where there is no significant change from the information contained in the initial application. Approved CEU's are posted at www.oesac.com and there are three ways to locate a course listing on the website: OESAC course ID, course title, or course sponsor name.
