



2023 NOWRA Educational Scholarship

Background:

The 2023 NOWRA Educational Scholarship is intended to support the professional development of young and early career professionals in the onsite wastewater industry. Two outstanding candidates will be selected based on their career aspirations and commitment to the onsite sector.

General Information:

- NOWRA will award two scholarships of up to \$2,000 each for educational expenses.
- In addition to the monetary compensation, scholarship recipients will be recognized on the NOWRA website and social media.
- Scholarship recipients will also receive a year of student level membership to NOWRA.

Eligibility:

1. Applicants must be enrolled at least part time in an academic school during 2023.
2. Applicants must be pursuing a degree or certification in a topic related to wastewater treatment and/or environmental policy and management. Academic programs that are applicable include:
 - Civil engineering
 - Environmental engineering
 - Agricultural engineering
 - Water resource management
 - Environmental policy
 - Environmental science
 - Agricultural sciences
 - Environmental health
 - Public health and policy
 - Plumbing or construction schools
 - Related Fields
3. Applicant must be either under 35 years of age or have less than 5 years of experience in the onsite wastewater field.
4. Applicants must fill out this application form in its entirety and must provide proof of enrollment (i.e., academic transcript, letter of enrollment, etc.) upon request.
5. Submit a resume (2 page maximum) as an attachment.
6. NOWRA or state affiliate membership is encouraged but not required.

Scholarship Deadlines and Timeline:

- Scholarship applications will remain open until 10 PM Eastern time on **September 8, 2023**.
- The winners will be announced at the 2023 Onsite Wastewater Mega Conference on **October 22-25, 2023** in Hampton, Virginia. In person attendance to the conference is encouraged but not required.
- Disbursement of the funds will occur shortly after the Mega Conference.
